FINAL BOARD DETERMINATION – EC2021 INDEPENDENT SPENDER

The New York City Campaign Finance Board (“Board”), at a meeting held on September 15, 2022, made the following final determination concerning NYSNA PAC:

Violations and Penalties

The Board determined that NYSNA PAC violated the New York City Charter and Board Rules and that the Independent Spender, NYSNA PAC, and its Authorized Representative, Alexander Rabb, are jointly and severally liable for paying \$7,290 in penalties as follows:

A penalty of \$7,290 for failing to file. *See* Board Rules 14-02, 14-03. The Spender reported seven digital advertisements distributed on June 17, supporting various candidates, with associated expenditures of \$29,162. These communications were subject to the daily disclosure requirements and should have been reported by June 19. The Spender disclosed these communications on June 22, the day of the primary election, constituting a failure to file. The Board assessed a penalty of 25% of the value of the expenditures.

The Board determined that the amount due is \$7,290.

You must pay to the Board the full amount due of **\$7,290** no later than **October 26, 2022**. Checks should be made payable to the “New York City Election Campaign Finance Fund,” and mailed to the attention of Joseph Gallagher, Senior Counsel, New York City Campaign Finance Board, 100 Church Street, 12th Floor, New York, NY 10007 or delivered to the offices of the Board.

If the Board is not in receipt of the full \$7,290 by October 26, 2022, the Independent Spender’s name and the unpaid amount will be posted on the Board’s Website and the Board may initiate a civil action against the Independent Spender and its Authorized Representative to compel payment.

You may challenge this final determination, within four months, in the New York State Supreme Court pursuant to Article 78 of the Civil Practice Law and Rules.
